### **Luke 24: 21 - 35**

**We Must Move From Being \_\_\_\_\_ To Believing Christ Is \_\_\_\_\_!**

### **Only Scripture Explains Who Christ Is.**

And Jesus said to them, “O \_\_\_\_\_ ones (unthinking and failing to pay attention to the right details), and slow of \_\_\_\_\_ (inner character and the moral capacity) to \_\_\_\_\_ (to have faith in and trust what God actually says) all that the prophets have spoken! <sup>26</sup> Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?” <sup>27</sup> And beginning with \_\_\_\_\_ and all the \_\_\_\_\_, he interpreted to them in all the \_\_\_\_\_ the things concerning himself. ### **Recognizing The Resurrection Requires Remembering Christ’s Role & His Purpose For Coming**

Luke 24: 31-34 <sup>31</sup>And their eyes were \_\_\_\_\_,(their souls were roused to understanding) and they \_\_\_\_\_ him. And he vanished from their sight. <sup>32</sup>They said to each other, “Did

not our hearts \_\_\_\_\_ (blazed, flamed or consumed with the Holy Spirit’s illumination) within us while he talked to us on the road, while he opened to us the Scriptures?”

(Matt 16:21, Matt 17: 22-23, Matt 20:17-19, Mark 8:31. Mark 9:12, Mark 10:34, Luke 9:22-25, Luke 17:25)

### **The 5 Things All Christians Must Burn in Belief To Bear \_\_\_\_\_ To The Resurrection Are:**

- 1) Christ was born of a virgin. (DNA = God’s & The Tribe of Judah’s through whom Mary descended.)
- 2) Christ lived a sinless life.
- 3) Christ died a substitutionary death. (Christ’s exemplary life qualified Him to be our substitute, as He hung on the Cross)
- 4) Christ bodily was resurrected from the dead.
- 5) Christ rules in resurrection at the right hand of God - as Lord of our lives!

Luke 24: 6 He is not here, but has \_\_\_\_\_. Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, Christ’s resurrection is evidence of the \_\_\_\_\_ that occurred in Col 2: 15 when <sup>15</sup>”He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him.”
